Q: How long is the airport transfer to Beaches Negril?

A: You'll fly into Sangster International (MBJ) in Montego Bay, and the ground transfer to Negril is 75-90 minutes on a good day, longer if your flight lands during afternoon traffic on the A1. Round-trip transfers are included in the Beaches rate, and the shuttle stops once at a roadside rest with clean bathrooms and a bar. Negril Aerodrome (NEG) exists for small-plane transfers if you want to skip the drive, but it's an extra cost most families skip.

Q: Which Beaches Negril room category is best for families?

A: Concierge-level Beachfront and Walkout suites are the sweet spot — you get access to the Concierge lounge, priority dinner reservations, and rooms that either sit directly on the beach or step onto the sand from the patio. Garden View rooms are fine if the savings fund a longer trip but feel dated in un-renovated wings. Butler Suites and Firesky Reserve villas sit at the top of the ladder, with butler service that's genuinely useful when traveling with small children.

Q: How does Beaches Negril compare to Beaches Turks & Caicos?

A: Beaches Turks & Caicos is the flagship — 21 restaurants, four themed villages, and a 10-15 minute airport transfer from Providenciales. Beaches Negril has noticeably fewer restaurants and a 75-90 minute transfer from Montego Bay, but sits on Seven-Mile Beach and runs at lower nightly rates. Negril is our #2 pick in the Beaches portfolio, and the quality gap is smaller than the price difference suggests.
