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Q: Is Sandals Montego Bay good for a honeymoon?

A: Sandals Montego Bay works best for honeymooners who prioritize short transfers, lower Jamaica pricing, and a heritage Sandals feel over total seclusion. If aircraft noise would bother you during beach time, choose a quieter Jamaica option such as Royal Plantation or Dunn's River instead.

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Q: How close is Sandals Montego Bay to the airport?

A: Sandals Montego Bay is roughly 1.5 miles from Sangster International Airport, with an included transfer that usually takes seven to twelve minutes. The upside is one of the fastest arrival experiences in the portfolio; the trade-off is frequent daytime aircraft noise over the beach.

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Q: Which rooms are best at Sandals Montego Bay?

A: The Crystal Lagoon Swim-Up Butler Suites are the strongest mid-tier value because they add butler service, direct pool access, and more space without jumping to the Rondoval price tier. Light sleepers should request a room away from airport-facing exposures.
