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Q: Is Sandals Ochi worth it?

A: Sandals Ochi is worth it for couples who want maximum restaurants, room categories, pools, and value in Jamaica. It is less compelling for travelers whose top priority is a wide walkable beach or a compact resort where everything is reachable in a few minutes.

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Q: How long is the transfer to Sandals Ochi?

A: Plan on roughly 75 to 90 minutes by road from Sangster International Airport in Montego Bay, depending on traffic. Ian Fleming International Airport is much closer, but most international travelers will still route through MBJ.

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Q: Which side of Sandals Ochi is better?

A: The village side is better for privacy, hillside views, and higher-end suite categories such as Skypool and private-pool villas. The beach side is better if you want faster access to the sand, spa, and main pool. Couples should choose based on whether room privacy or beach access matters more.
